What is the overall Deductible ?	\$300 person/ \$600 family	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from Providers up to the Deductible amount before this Plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the Plan , each family member must meet their own individual Deductible until the total amount of Deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family Deductible .
Are there services covered before you meet your Deductible ?	Yes. Pharmacy, hospice care, Copays or listed In-Network immunizations and Preventive Care are covered before you meet your Deductible .	This Plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the Deductible amount. But a Copayment or Cost Sharing may apply. For example, this Plan covers certain Preventive Services without Cost Sharing and before you meet your Deductible . What is not included in the Out-of-pocket Limit ?	Contributions, Balance-Billing charges and health care this Plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the Out-of-pocket Limit .
